HISPANIC HERITAGE ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND STUDENT APPLICATION © 1/23

The Hispanic Heritage Association of Northwest Louisiana (HHANWLA) was established in 2021 with the objective of creating an association devoted to the progression and development of Hispanics in the region, including culture, education, health, sports, business, arts, and more, through events and partnerships with other associations. We consider education a important part of the progression of our local youth. As part of HHANWLA's education efforts, the Scholarship Fund was established in 2023 to provide scholarships to Latino students attending colleges and universities.

TERMS: The Scholarship Council will award scholarships to qualified Latino students who are enrolled or are planning to enroll in accredited colleges or universities in the United States. Awards will be \$1,000 each. All awards will be presented at the annual Hispanic Heritage Noche de Gala on October 12 in Shreveport. It is preferred that you will accept the scholarship at the event. Scholarships may be used for the payment of tuition, academic fees, room, board, and the purchase of required educational materials & books.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicants must be a U.S. citizen, legal permanent resident, or be granted Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA).
- Must have applied to or be enrolled as a full-time student in a college or university, including 2-year colleges, or vocational schools that lead to an associate's degree. Graduate students must have applied to or be enrolled as a part-time student in a college or university.
- A student will not be eligible for a scholarship if he/she is related to a scholarship committee member, the Council President, or an individual contributor to the local funds of the Council

AWARD CRITERIA: Applicants are eligible for the following three types of scholarship awards:

Gold Achievement Awards (\$1,000)

Grades and academic performance will serve as indicators; however, emphasis may be placed on the individual's motivation, sincerity, and integrity, which can best be revealed through a personal interview and in the personal essay. Need, community involvement, and leadership activities will also be considered.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Applicants must submit the following in order to be considered for an HHANWLA scholarship:

- Completed and signed application form
- High school or college transcript, including cumulative GPA
- Verification of admittance or enrollment from the institution the student is attending or planning to attend (i.e. – letter of acceptance, letter from the registrar, or a transcript)
- Typed, or neatly printed, personal essay of not more than 500 words

TIME LINE:

July 31 : Application due to Scholarship Council.

September 15 : Applicants notified of scholarship award.

October 12: Scholarship awards presentation at Hispanic Heritage Noche De Gala, Shreveport
